Empowering clients to live healthy, self-sufficient, and fulfilling lives through physical and mental wellness programs, strong healthcare partnerships, and advancing intergenerational well-being.

Healthy Communities

To create sustainable health programming that fosters awareness, educates and supports the health and wellness of our Latino and immigrant community.

Club de niños saludables, or Healthy Kids Club, focuses on preventing childhood obesity and promoting lifelong health in a fun and engaging way through nutrition education and physical activity. Activities include Zumba, yoga, healthy cooking demonstrations, and other workshops and activities.

Additional Health and Wellness Strategies

Healthy Communities promotes well-being through education, health services, and community events in partnership with local healthcare organizations. Programming includes health screenings, vaccine clinics, CPR and First Aid training, Youth Mental Health First Aid, Bienvenido, free mammograms, and the annual Women's Health Conference.

Cultivate Wellness

Providing clients with the skills, training, and resources to grow fresh produce, fostering food security, self-sufficiency, healthy living, and stronger community bonds through home gardening.

Cultivate Wellness, is a free at-home gardening and health initiative designed to empower clients with the knowledge, skills, and resources to grow their own fresh, culturally appropriate produce. The program improves access to affordable, healthy food using gardening as a catalyst to meet broader health and social needs in the Omaha community.

Through hands-on training and weekly home visits, staff support low-income households in building and sustaining home gardens, providing health education, referrals to essential services, and guidance that promotes healthier lifestyles, stronger community bonds, and long-term resilience.
